

Aspen Yellow Leaf Invitational **Saturday October 20th – Sunday October 21st 2007**

- Sanction: Held under the sanction of USA Swimming # 2007-076
- Facility: Aspen Recreation Center Pool, Maroon Creek Road, Aspen, Colorado. Indoor 25 yard, 6 lane pool.
- Timing: Colorado Timing System 6 with 6 lane scoreboard, pad and backup timing. All events are timed finals.
- Format: A two day meet with a full schedule of events. Each swimmer may enter up to 4 individual events and one relay each day.
- Schedule: Session #1: Warm-up - Saturday 11am; Start – 12:15 pm
Session #2: Warm-up – 15minute warm-up beginning immediately after the conclusion of session #1

Session #3: Warm-up – Sunday 8 am; Start – 9:15am

Session #1 and #3 warm-ups will be split warm-ups.
- Rules: Current USA swimming rules will govern meet procedure. The meet referee will be final authority. The meet is pre-seeded. Age will be determined as of October 20th, 2007. Open to all swimmers on the Western Slope League of Colorado Swimming, Inc., holding a 2007 USA Swimming membership card. Any swimmer who appears on the CSI exceptions report without registration must come to the meet prepared to show their card. **NO** deck registrations will be accepted.

Colorado Swimming warm-up procedures will be followed.

- Coaches & Officials: All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA/CSI cards while on deck. Current certification for all coaches is mandatory. Coaches that are not in compliance will not be allowed on deck.
- Entry Fee: The entry fee will be \$15.00 flat fee per swimmer. From these fees \$0.50 per entry will go to CSI and \$0.15 per entry will go to Zone 4. There will be a \$10.00 surcharge for LATE entries. Make one check payable to: Aspen Swim Club.

Entries: Entries must be received by the entry chair in HY-TEK MEET MANAGER format by 6:00 PM Friday, October 12th. Entries will be accepted by email prior to this deadline, but we must receive your hard copy by the posted deadline. Please include hard copies of the data including name, age, USA number, team code, and entry times in yards. NT will be accepted but will be seeded into the slowest heats. **The Colorado Swimming Meet Verification form must accompany all entries.** Please include coach's name, address and phone number.

Team Manager event template will be available after September 5, 2007. Deck entries will not be accepted.

Entries are limited to the first 150. Entry max per swimmer is 4 per day, 1 relay per day, totaling 10.

Scoring & Awards:

Events will be scored in the following fashion:

8 & under events will be scored as 6&under and 8&under,

10& under events will be scored as 8& under and 9-10

12& under events will be scored as 8& under, 9-10, 11-12

11 & over events will be scored as 11-12, 13-14, 15&over

Individual OPEN events will be scored as 10&under, 11-12, 13-14, 15&over

All relays will not be broken into age group

Scoring is for team totals only. There are no individual event awards. There are no high point awards. Each swimmer will receive a motivational time card.

Results:

Results will be emailed to each team. If your team requires mailed results please put a request in writing in your entry packet, along with a self-addressed envelope large enough to handle the results.

Programs

Programs will be available for purchase for \$5.00 per program.

Additional Info:

Each team will be asked to provide timers for the duration of each session. No smoking allowed on deck, in the building or any area frequented by swimmers. No glass bottles on deck or in the restrooms. A snack bar will be open throughout the meet.

All 8 & under individual events will start in the shallow end of the pool. Diving entries will be determined on the day of the meet.

Courtesy Times: 400 IM (8:00.00) and 500 Freestyle (9:00.00) are requested.

Warmups: Two thirty minute warm up will be conducted for sessions #1 and #3 in accordance with Colorado Swimming Inc. established procedures. Assigned lanes will be provided.
