#### Swim suits

Just general comments as schedule not finalized. Discussion at Zone 4 meeting concerning moving silver state meet before JO's. This will probably happen. It may "crunch" the summer swim meet schedule, though. CSI had asked if Western Slope would consider dropping Western Slope Championship. NO ONE in favor of that.

### Other

Also reported that we still owe money to the city for registrations from this year for people that took advantage of ducky derby credits from last year.
