

Aspen Speedos Board Meeting
May 10, 2005

Attending: Candice, Greg, Kelly, Jenny, Marc, Laura, Nona, Steve, Archie, Gordon

1. Registration: Our current numbers are right on target with the budget Greg worked on total receipts \$17,720- apx. 55 swimmers. This breaks down to 28 full, 7 partial, 14 developmental, 1 daily. Included in this are 12 siblings.
2. Lane time/cost: We are currently paying \$13/lane per hour. Marc thinks, as do all of us that the cost is very high. Marc has been checking costs with other clubs and organizations and we are much higher than most. Laura and Greg will discuss this with Tim. Right now we are using 5 lanes- this will work until we start morning practices in June and then we will have 5 lanes from 7:30am-8:00am and then all 6 lanes for the rest of practice.
3. Coaching Level: Marc is very comfortable with the swimmer /coach ratio. Jenny has had a lot of beginner swimmers but feels that she can handle it as well.
4. Ernie Fyrwald- Ernie's company donated \$1000
5. Boogie: Boggie has pledged a donation of \$2000
6. Meet schedule change- Gunnison: Greg e-mailed everyone that we decided to switch the June 4th meet to attend Gunnison instead of Steamboat. We are recommending people contact the Comfort Inn- rooms are apx. \$59/night
7. Swim meet organization meetings/update: We will continue meeting every Tuesday at the hospital. Laura and Nona meet with Stan and Kevin from the Thunderbowl Café to discuss the concessions for our swim meet July 8-10th. They are excited to work with us on this event and will give us a proposal within the next week outlining cost for the 2 lunches for officials and coaches and also the concessions they will offer at the pool.
8. Practice Meet- timing system practice: We decided to hold a practice meet on Thursday, May 26th. Greg will e-mail the team to encourage all members to attend. We will also take the team picture as well. Laura will ask Sue Jackson if she is interested in taking the team photo. There will be no practice on 5/27.

9. Fins: We will require full season competitive swimmers to have fins. We will ask swimmers to bring old fins to practice, which we will announce later, and we will have a swap. We can order new fins for those who need them. Marc thinks he will have swimmers use them a few times each week.
10. Ducky Derby/Triathlon: Pat Buettow will handle the organization of Ducky Derby and Anne MacLean and Laura will help with the Triathlon.
